RESPONSIVE READING for Reformation Sunday

***Sola Gratia*—by Grace Alone**

Worship Leader: The true purpose of human life is to glorify God and to enjoy him forever. This purpose can be achieved only through God's unmerited favor, freely bestowed by God through Jesus Christ, who is the only way of salvation for all peoples everywhere.

Congregation: As heralds of God's gracious love, we are called to proclaim the message of Jesus Christ throughout all the world.

(Westminster Catechism, Q&A 1)

Worship Leader: For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Congregation: and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

(Rom. 3:23-24)

***Sola Fide*—by Faith Alone**

Worship Leader: We respond to God's initiative in salvation through personal trust in the Redeemer.

Congregation: We are made right with God by faith alone, which means that we belong—body and soul, in life and in death, not to ourselves but to our faithful Savior, Jesus Christ, who has fully paid for all our sins and makes us wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.

(adapted from Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 1)

Worship Leader: Know that a person is not justified by observing the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ.

Congregation: So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ.

(Gal. 2:16)

***Sola Scriptura*—The Scriptures Alone**

Worship Leader: God is once and for all revealed to us through the words of Scripture. The Bible is the supreme standard by which all human conduct and opinion should be tried.

Congregation: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that all God's people may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

(2 Tim. 3:16-17)

Worship Leader: Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles.

Congregation: And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. *(Heb. 12:1-2)*

Worship Leader: God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

Congregation: Therefore, we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging.

Worship Leader: "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

Congregation: The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. *(excerpts Psalm 46)*
